



DESCRIPTION

Sea Meetings is an environmental education and ocean literacy project involving educational communities in spreading knowledge of the ocean and coastal areas, inducing changes in attitudes and behaviors towards sustainability of marine and coastal ecosystems. Through a set of outreach activities, dissemination of knowledge and learning mediation, addressed to students of secondary education, and training of teachers, the educational community will be mobilized for dynamic events on the sea in its community. Schools of Continental Portugal and the Azores will organize Sea Meetings, during the month of May 2014, which will be discussed in the sea and coastal areas, integrating the local community in an exchange network that involves seven coastal School Groups and the interior of Portugal and one of Faial, the Portuguese Association of Environmental Education, the Oceanography Centre and the Educatis Training Centre. These events will be integrated into the school activity plans and included into the schoolar curricula throughout the school year.
